Our objective with the Invited Junior Membership (IJM) program is to provide an opportunity for a junior tennis or squash player, whose parents are not Jericho Tennis Club Members, to join the Club as an IJM.

Founded in 1916, the Jericho Tennis Club is a premier private racquets club located in Vancouver, British Columbia. Boasting incredible views of the ocean and mountains, the Club is ideally situated on the Jericho Beach and caters to approximately 3,000 Members. Unique among west coast clubs, the Jericho Tennis Club serves its Membership by providing facilities and activities that promote racquet sports as well as supplementary recreational and social activities. These activities are carried out in an environment that respects and supports the facility and activity needs of its full Membership.

Jericho Tennis Club (JTC) encourages responsible, devoted junior tennis and squash players who are looking for a private Club Membership, to help improve and enhance their game to submit an application for Membership. By accepting applications from Juniors whose parents are not members, the Club is looking to build upon its existing Junior Membership and to establish a critical mass of Junior Members at all levels of play.

There are two submission deadlines per year: October 31 and June 30. There are limited quotas of how many applications we may accept each intake.

Jericho Tennis Club is pleased to offer IJM Memberships to young individuals between the ages of eight and fourteen whose parents are not members of Jericho Tennis Club.

In applying for an IJM Membership they are making a declaration that they intend to make a commitment to play tennis and /or squash on an ongoing basis, and represent Jericho Tennis Club. The desire to be an IJM is an important part of developing and maintaining a lifelong passion for racquet sports and being a Club Member.

Only those applicants that will best support the existing Junior program will be accepted. A meeting between the selected applicant and Club representatives will be required before a final decision is reached. Unsuccessful candidates are invited to resubmit at a later date.

IJM membership will be reviewed annually. As a requirement the IJM is expected to be active in the Club's Junior programs and interclub league programs including; in house leagues and ladders, adult ladders, Club junior tournaments, provincially sanctioned tournaments, and special events.

It is expected that Jericho Tennis Club is the primary training facility and Club for the IJM. The IJM will be expected to participate in 50% of available programming, being active in lessons, internal events, ladders, and court bookings.

In applying the applicant must understand and be ready to commit to the following program / membership criteria that needs to be met annually:

1. IJM's will be expected to represent Jericho as their home club when playing outside competitions and tournaments and to continually demonstrate good sportsmanship and conduct both on and off court.
2. IJM's will have access to private coaching and programs by our Pro staff, however any private lesson time will be offered first to Junior members.
3. IJM applicants will be required to support their application for Membership with two letters of endorsement.
4. IJM Members are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship and conduct on and off the court.

IJM Members who do not meet these expectations may, at any time, have their Membership canceled at the discretion of the Club's Head Professionals or upon review by the Membership Manager. IJM Members are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship and conduct on and off the court.



PRIVILEGES, DUES & FEES

Individuals applying to join the Club are required to pay an initial Administration Fee with the application and monthly Membership dues. The Administration Fee is a one-time fee payable with the application and cashed once approved into the Club. The Administration Fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. All fees and dues are subject to GST.

- Administration Fee: \$525.00 including GST.
- Current Monthly Dues: \$51.35+ GST
- Any other applicable program fees, lessons, events, etc. that the IJM participates in

An IJM Membership offers the same privileges as a Junior Membership, and entitles the individual access to the clubhouse, pool, squash facilities, and tennis facilities at specified times as set forth in the Club Rules.

An IJM Membership allows the individual to participate in a number of Club sponsored racquet activities, which include:

- Junior Opening and other Club events
- Junior Social Events
- Interclub league or in-house ladders, tournaments and summer drop in sessions
- Access to private and group coaching
- JTC facilities (pool, courts, junior lounge, junior locker room, and dining)
- Gym access at 13+ (with permission granted)

Upon acceptance, the full list of Rules and Bylaws will be provided.



The parents of IJM Members are **not** Members of the Club; they have no Membership, or club use privileges. Parent(s) of IJM's are only permitted on Club property in a supervisory role while their child is participating in a Club lesson or program.

- An IJM over 13 years of age may introduce a parent or both parents as their Social Guest(s) two times per month. Guest rules and fees apply.

An IJM Membership allows the individual to access to the clubhouse, pool, squash facilities, and tennis facilities with guests at specified times as set forth in the Club Rules.

- IJM's may bring a maximum of two guests for a squash or tennis court booking. Guest rules and fees apply, and each guest shall not be introduced more than twice a month.
- Invited Juniors under the age of 13 may not introduce social guests at any time.
- Invited Juniors under the age of 13 may not introduce swim guests at any time. Invited Juniors 13 years and older may introduce up to two social guests at one time. Guest rules and fees apply, and each guest shall not be introduced more than twice a month.
- Invited Juniors 13 years and older may introduce one swimming guest. Guest rules and fees apply, and each guest shall not be introduced more than twice a month.
- Invited Juniors may not bring an adult guest to have use of the Fitness Centre. No guests are permitted in the Fitness Centre.



At the age of sixteen all types of Junior Membership cease.

At this point, as long as all criteria is still being met annually by the IJM, the IJM must apply for Intermediate Membership in order to maintain their spot at the Club. The privileges will change to adult playing hours and adult Clubhouse privileges within areas that are not liquor license controlled areas. Membership ceases when criteria is no longer met or on one's nineteenth birthday if Entrance Fees are not paid.

If the transition to Intermediate membership happens on one's 16th birthday, the membership transition will happen seamlessly without being subject to the Club's Applicant Waitlist.

There are two category types to that can be applied for:

1. Apply for an Intermediate Full Play Membership
2. Apply for an Intermediate Squash Membership

On ones nineteenth birthday, all Intermediate Members intending to remain at Jericho must place a 5% deposit of their total Entrance fee followed by an installment plan or pay for the Entrance Fee in full.

If a deposit is not received, membership will cease, and a formal resignation will be due. There will be no Club access or privileges moving forward.

If membership has ceased and the former member wishes to apply at a later time in life, they will be subject to the regular application process, waitlist times and procedures.



APPLY WITH A COMPLETE APPLICATION

Applications will be considered incomplete and returned to the applicant if any the following requirements are not met:

1. Application must be complete with both the applicant and parent's signature.
2. Applicant must fill out the "What you will bring to Jericho and why you should be selected as a new Invited Junior Member" section in their own words.
3. Two letters of endorsement are attached. Endorsement letter requirements:
 - a) Letter from the Club's Head Tennis or Head Squash Professional or a Jericho Tennis Club Member, if they have been trained by them before.
 - b) Letter(s) from applicants' current coach, teacher or individual who may attest to the applicant's character, desire and passion for racquets sports (may not be from a parent/s or family member/s).
4. The enclosed questionnaire is answered in full.
5. In applying the applicant must understand and be ready to commit to the following program and membership criteria that needs to be met annually:
 - IJM membership will be reviewed annually. As a requirement the IJM will be expected to be active in the Club's Junior programs, interclub league and competitions, in house leagues and ladders, adult ladders, Club junior tournaments and special events. IJM will be expected to participate in 50% of available programming, including at least two terms of programming and 50% of Junior activities outside of programming. IJM's who are not fulfilling these expectations may have their IJM membership revoked at the discretion of the Club at any time.
 - IJM's will be expected to represent Jericho as their home club when playing outside competitions and tournaments and to continually demonstrate good sportsmanship and conduct both on and off court.
 - IJM's will have access to private coaching by our Pro staff, however any private lesson time will be offered first to Junior members.
7. An Administration Fee cheque payable to Jericho Tennis Club in the amount of \$525.00 is attached (\$500 + \$25 GST). Please note the deposit cheque will not be cashed until the application is approved and the applicant is accepted as an IJM Member of the Club.
